Head Lacrosse Coach at Bryant University... Assistant Coach 2002 Gold Medal Team USA ... Coached 83 All-Americans ... 42 North-South All-Stars ... Coach of the South All-Star Team 1993 ... USILA National Division I Coach of The Year 2005 ... NCAA Coach of the Year 1987 Div III ... ACC Champions 1995, 2001, 2002 ... NCAA Final Four 1997, 2005 ... Ranked as high as 2nd nationally ... 15 year Record at Duke 148-77...100 % graduation rate ... In his first year as head coach of Bryant University, Pressler guided the Bulldogs to their first ever Northeast-10 Conference regular season title and a top seed in the conference tournament playoffs. During the 2007 season, Bryant tied a school record with 10 consecutive wins including an undefeated 9-0 mark in the Northeast-10. Among those wins was an overtime victory against defending national champion Le Moyne, snapping the Dolphin's 70-game win streak.
